Here is some information you will want to be familiar with - (If you are new to the group you'll receive detailed information on us in the mail or see our website - 2047.org or Join2047.com).

Stockade meetings run from 7-8:30pm. Drop off is no earlier than 6:45 and pickup by 8:45. You must come into the building to pick up your boy. Tuesday Stockade is on hold until later in the year.

Registration for Stockade is \$75/boy but if registration is paid for by October 11th the cost is \$65. You pay the registration via our website (left hand column). You can also setup an automatic payment in 4 monthly charges if that is easier for you. If there is any problem in paying the registration, or costs involved, let me know. Stockade does not have a set "dues" and unlike the Scouts, Little League, Football, Soccer or school

- we don't sell candy bars, hold raffles, or take part in any fund-raising. Some of our operating money comes from a voluntary giving we call shares. We request that each boy bring 50¢ - \$1.00 a week. We receive generous funding from the Wesleyan Church of Orchard Park, our Leaders and donations from parents and others. 

Tuesday Stockade was combined into Wednesday 2 years ago to cut down the cleaning required by the custodial staff during Covid.

There is no Monday Battalion this year. The boys that are 12 & 13 will remain in Stockade in a separate small group. They will do much of the same activities as the other boys but some of them will be aged up for guys their age. This group is limited in size.
